



Exporting and uploading mixing instructions:

1. Refrain from processing tracks before sending them in for mixing. Turn your fx and leveling choices off. In case you're certain of a specific fx/sound, export the processed AND unprocessed track.

All tracks audio files must be clearly named. Try including the microphone used for each track, e.g. Vocals_Main_u87.

2. Export every single track of your song. Don't sum to stems or sub-busses. Any MIDI tracks need to be converted and printed as continuous audio files.

All tracks should start on the same (first) bar.

Format: Wav 44.1 khz, at least 16 bit depth, 24bit wav preferable.

3. Compress the tracks folder into a Rar or Zip. Name it according to your song accompanied by its bpm (tempo), e.g. Two_Hands_115.

Rough mixes can be included in the compressed file as well.

4. Upload the rar into a free hosting service like rapidshare, megaupload, dropbox, sendspace etc, or your personal server.
